One of Eugene' key field of expertise is in social procurement, where he has been a leader in the resource sector over the last 5 years. He will share his experience in his role for BHP Billiton, where he managed the development of the Aboriginal Participation Sourcing Charter and associated social procurement policies. He worked closely with key stakeholders to increase direct aboriginal enterprise annual spend by 400% to approximately \$10m.

Eugene will provide a brief overview of the Commonwealth Indigenous Procurement Policy and his thoughts on how to achieve a competitive market advantage. Eugene will also provide an overview of the GROW Project (aimed to counter ongoing joblessness and related disadvantage in the Geelong region in Victoria). He will also cover development details of a practical Social Procurement Toolkit.
