Opening with an introduction to Port Botany, from the private managers, NSW Ports, this tour will explain and show you the workings of one of the stevedoring terminals, as well as a drive through the port surrounds.

The tour will start with NSW Ports introduction to the workings of Port Botany, the current trade statistics as well as the future initiatives in place. This includes an overview of the NSW Ports 30 Year Masterplan. From there attendee's will be given a tour of one of the stevedoring terminals, where you will see up close the life of a container, from ship to shore, then stack to truck and train.

The final stage of the tour will be a drive around the port to see other points of interest, including the Bulk Liquids Berth, Container Freight Stations, Empty Container Parks and the Customs X-Ray Facility.
