Australia Post has undertaken a major upgrade to their parcel sortation systems in both Sydney and Melbourne in recent years to keep up with the high demand on their services. This tour provides a unique opportunity to see this facility up close and personal and experience how one of Australia's leading Logistics businesses performs the sortation of their product.

Some facts about Sydney Parcel Facility (SPF) include:

- In December 2017 they recorded the highest throughput in their history, sorting 464,000 parcels across the sortation system and 561,000 in total.
- They currently employ approximately 560 staff.
- The machines scan and sort parcels on 2.88km of conveyor belts that move at 2.4m per second.
